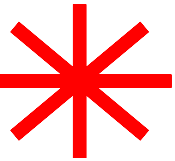

The name of the presenting author should be underlined. All abstracts must be submitted in English.

The deadline for submission of abstracts, which will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee, is May 1, 2007. The presenting author will be notified of acceptance or rejection of his/her paper around June 1, 2007.

The full-sized manuscripts will be published by the SPIE. Limited number of selected papers will be published in peer-reviewed journals.
